Ahmedabad Metro sees over one lakh riders on normal day

Ahmedabad: The Ahmedabad Metro created a record this week by witnessing of over 1 lakh riders on a normal day. Earlier, the metro had recorded over 1 lakh riders on festival days and when IPL matches are played at the Narendra Modi Stadium in Motera.

A statement from the Gujarat Metro Rail Corporation said that for the first time, the ridership

went up to 1,00,830 on May 14 and then to 1,00,893 on Thursday, which were "non-match, non-public function" days. The Phase 1 of the Metro was inaugurated on September 29, 2022. On IPL match days, the Metro has been handling more than a lakh passengers, the statement said, adding that it had registered the highest ridership of 1,59,240 on May 10.
