

# Metro crosses 1L daily passenger mark

As many people used the service on May 14 and May 16; the surge was seen on days that weren't public holidays nor days when there was a match at the Narendra Modi Stadium

The Gujarat Metro Rail Corporation (GMRC) operated Ahmedabad Metro crossed the landmark 1 lakh daily passenger figure for the first time since the inauguration of Ahmedabad Metro Phase 1 in September 2022. The metro reported 1 lakh ridership a day twice in one week. Interestingly this came on regular weekdays that were neither public holidays nor match days.

On May 14, a total of 1,00,830 people travelled on the metro, while on May 16, 1,00,893 people used the service. These numbers were recorded on standard weekdays when there were no public holidays or matches at the Narendra Modi Stadium. It should be noted that Metro often sees a surge in passengers during public holidays or match days.

Notably, since March 24, the metro's ridership has also consistently exceeded 1 lakh on IPL match days. On May 10, a match day, the metro saw its highest ridership with 1,59,214 passengers.

According to GMRC data, the initial average daily ridership after the inauguration of Ahmedabad Metro

was 39,000, which has been on the upswing since then. Recently, weekday ridership has ranged between

93,000 and 1 lakh, while holiday ridership remains between 75,000 and 80,000.
