# Entire world knows India is best bet for 21st century, says Modi

## 'Those Filled With Hatred Defaming India'

**Gandhinagar:** PM Narendra Modi on Monday emphasized that the world acknowledges India to be the best bet for the 21st century.

"India's diversity, scale, capacity, potential, performance, all are unique. That is why I say Indian solutions for global applications. The world is understanding this very well. Not just India, the entire world is of the belief that India is the best bet for the 21st century," Modi said in his inaugural address at the 4th edition of the Global Renewable Energy Investors Meet and Expo (RE-INVEST 2024) at Mahatma Mandir Exhibition and Convention Centre in Gandhinagar.

## HIGH SPEED TRAINS & RE INVESTMENTS

- PM inaugurated and travelled in phase II of the Metro rail extension connecting twin cities

- At RE-Invest 2024, Reliance Industries Limited committed to develop the highest RE Capacity in India of 100GW by 2030. This is followed by NTPC at 41.3 GW, ReNew Power at 41 GW, Adani Green at 38.8GW and Hero Future Energies at 28.25 GW

The three-day RE-INVEST 2024 summit will witness the participation of some 25,000 delegates from across 140 countries, more than 200 speakers and over 115 B2B meetings.

The PM said India is the first G20 country to meet climate commitments made in Paris nine years before the deadline. "We did what developed nations could not do," he said, adding that since the country does not have its own oil and gas resources

and is not energy independent, it has decided to build its future on the strength of solar, wind, nuclear, and hydro power.

Later, speaking at an event in Ahmedabad where he launched projects worth Rs 8,000 crore, Modi mounted a scathing attack on the opposition alleging certain individuals filled with hate and negativity are defaming the country.
