From tomorrow, take direct Metro from Ahmedabad to Gandhinagar's Sector-1, GIFT City

FROM SATURDAY, commuters wishing to go from Ahmedabad to Sector-1 or GIFT City in Gandhinagar will no longer have to change Metro trains at Motera stadium or Gujarat National Law University (GNLU) to reach their destination.

The Gujarat Metro Rail

Corporation (GMRC) on Thursday said February 15 onwards, it would start direct Metro rides from APMC in Ahmedabad to the two key locations in the capital city. In a statement, the GMRC said that it had received permission from the Commissioner of Metro Rail Safety to increase the frequency of Metro trains between Ahmedabad and Gandhinagar. Earlier, those going from Ahmedabad to Gandhinagar

would have to change metro trains at Motera. Similarly, those travelling from GIFT City to

Ahmedabad would have to change Metro trains at GNLU. The GMRC further said that

bus services will also be available between GNLU station and Gift City offices every 30 minutes, and will make a stoppage at Pandit Deendayal Energy University (PDEU). Six trains each, back and forth, will ply on the APMC-Motera-GNLU-GIFT City route.

On the other hand, 14 trains will run on the APMC-Motera-GNLU-Sector-1 route while 15 of them will ply on the reverse route.
