Metro rail service extended for Ind-Eng Wednesday's ODI

Ahmedabad: The Ahmedabad metro rail will extend its operations until midnight on Wednesday to accommodate spectators attending the India vs England One-Day International (ODI) match at the Narendra Modi Stadium in Motera.

The Gujarat Metro Rail Corporation has confirmed metro services will operate in Ahmedabad, with trains running every eight minutes on both the Motera to APMC and Thaltej Gam to Vastral Gam routes.

After 10pm, passengers can enter only through Motera and Sabarmati stations. Special paper tickets, required for travel after 10 pm, will he available for advance purchase at designated stations including Nirant Crossroads, Apparel Park, Kalupur, Old High Court, Thaltej, Motera, Sabarmati, Ranip, Vadaj, and Jivraj Park Metro Stations. The authorities have clarified that QR-based tickets, tokens or mobile app bookings will not be valid af-

ter 10pm. The traffic department has implemented diversions, restricting vehicle movement from Janpath 'T' Junction to Narendra Modi Stadium main gate via Krupa Residency 'T' Junction to Motera Gam Junction.

Vehicles will be allowed to move from Tapovan Circle to ONGC Crossroads via Visat 'T' Junction to Power House Crossroads. Additionally, traffic towards Apollo Circle will be permitted via Bhat-Koteshwar Road, passing through Krupa Residency 'T Junction and Sharan Status Crossroads.
