Honourable Joint MD, GMRCL addressed to employees before start of lecture/workshop and stated importance of observance of Vigilance Awareness Week. 
Lecture on Vigilance Clearance





Shri Vikas Dadhich, CVO, GMRCL had delivered lecture on "Vigilance Clearance (VC)". He explained the meaning of Vigilance Clearance, its purpose, scenarios and ground for denial. He also advised employee of GMRCL to act in manner so that no ground for denial of VC arise, when requirement of VC asked for various purposes. He also emphasized the importance of VC for employees in various purposes like promotion, foreign training visit etc. Further, He demonstrated 13 point proforma of vigilance clearance provided by central vigilance commission (CVC) and list of Office Memorandums which contains important instructions published by Government of India for the vigilance clearance.

Lecture on Local Inspection





Shri Rajan Giri, VO, GMRCL had delivered lecture on "Local Inspection". He stated the meaning of local inspection, its objectives, types and implementation at employee and departmental level so that preventive vigilance measures can be effectively implemented and ensured. He explained how department can do local inspection and integrate it in their daily functioning. Further, he also stated possible general criteria regarding what can be include in local inspection according to various departmental and management level requirement.

Cyber Security Awareness For GMRCL

Shri Bipin Khot, Director, Department of Telecommunication, Government of India had delivered lecture on "Cyber Security Awareness". He explained about cyber security and its importance. He stated various frauds and attacks like identity theft, Phishing/Smishing, Social Media Frauds, Banking fraud, SIM Swap Fraud, Malware- Malicious Software attack, Ransomware attack, Data Exfiltration, Supply Chain attack etc. He also explained how these frauds and attacks could be carried out using various devices and methods like Virus Attack by Juice Jacking, ATTINY 85, USB Kill, Shark Jack, Raspberry Pi and Wi-fi Attack. He advised basic precautions and methods for preventing individual and organization from such frauds and attacks. He also suggested hardware security measures for protecting various equipment and hardware.

He described labour laws like 'The Minimum Wages Act, 1948'; 'The Contract Labour (R & A) Act, 1970' and explained provisions contained in them like Applicability, Purpose, New Minimum Wage Rates, Major Compliances, Inspecting Authority, Registration & License and Penalties Provisions. He suggested points need to follow at the time of Appointment/Termination of employee and Compliances need to verify at the time of appointment of Contractor and approving the invoices of Contractors.

A Quiz Competition was arranged among GMRCL employees who attended lecture/workshop on 30th October 2025. The aim of this competition was to create general awareness about Vigilance Mechanism in India, Central Vigilance Commission (CVC) and its guidelines and instruction related to Vigilance functions.
