AMC to launch single card for BRTS, AMTS, Metro

Rs 470 crore unified mobility project will integrate GSRTC buses and Bullet Train at a later stage

After spending crores on Janmitra cards — a single card for AMTS and BRTS — the Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation (AMC) is set to roll out yet another ambitious project aimed at creating a unified mobility system, at an estimated cost of Rs 470 crore.

The system, expected to be implemented within a year, will be supported by a mobile application. Passengers will be able to purchase tickets by scanning a QR code and access comprehensive information on routes and destinations, promising a smoother and more informed com-



mute. Standing committee chairman Devang Dani said the project would feature a unified journey planner. The company awarded the tender will be responsible not only for implementation but also for operations and maintenance for 12 years. Hardware and software upgrades will be carried out every five years, with the cost already built into the tender.

In the future, the system will be integrated with Metro services, GSRTC and the proposed high-speed



bullet train, Dani added.

Meanwhile, AMC said it has intensified action to ease traffic congestion across the city. Between 1 April and 15 December, encroachments including 11,457 lari-gallas, boards, banners and hoardings were removed. During the same period, 18,488 illegally parked vehicles were locked and 18,175 vehicles were fined.

Administrative charges amounting to Rs 1,10,19,000 were recovered, the civic body said.
