Crime in Metro? Now, 2 police stns will handle it

Police Commissioner designates Paldi and Khokhra police stations as nodal points for crimes related to the city's Metro Rail network

City police chief GS Malik has issued a public notification to streamline the process to register crimes related to the city's Metro Rail network.

At present, the city's operational Metro network spans over 60 kilometres and passes through several police station jurisdictions. To eliminate confusion and enhance efficiency in handling incidents on Metro trains or at Metro property, the city has been divided into two sectors, with specific police stations assigned exclusive authority to register such offences.

Police officials believe the move will strengthen response time, improve coordination, and offer greater convenience to the public using the rapidly expanding Metro network.

Sector-1: Paldi

Under the new order, all crimes occurring inside Metro trains or involving Metro assets within Sector-1 will be



registered at Paldi police station. Sector-1 covers areas falling under Zones 1, 7, 2 and 3, including police station jurisdictions such as Vastrapur, Sola, Ghatlodia, Gujarat University, Naranpura, Navrangpura, Sabarmati Riverfront West, Vadaj, Ellisbridge, Sarkhej, Vasna, Vejalpur, Bodakdev, Anandnagar, Paldi, Satellite, Chandkheda, Madhavpura, Ranip, Sabarmati, Sabarmati Riverfront East, Karanj, Shahpur, Kalupur, Shaherkotda, Gaekwad Haveli and Khadia. Passengers facing incidents such as theft, assault, molestation, obscene behaviour or damage to Metro buildings, platforms or wiring in these areas must approach Paldi police station to lodge a complaint.

Officials say this measure will prevent commuters from being redirected between multiple police stations.

Sector-2: Khokhra

For Sector-2, covering Zones 4, 5 and 6—all Metro-related crimes will be registered at Khokhra police station. This sector includes areas such as Dariapur, Shahibaug, Airport, Krishnanagar, Meghaninagar, Naroda, Sardarnagar, Bapunagar, Gomtipur, Rakhial, Amraiwadi, Khokhra, Nikol, Odhav, Ramol, Isanpur, Maninagar, Vatva, Vatva GIDC, Danilimda, Kagadapith and Narol. Any offences committed inside Metro trains or involving Metro infrastructure here must be reported at Khokhra station.

Local incidents at respective police station

The order clarifies that incidents unrelated to Metro trains or Metro property, such as altercations occurring solely on station premises, will continue to be handled by the respective local police stations having territorial jurisdiction.
